Utilize the suggestions below to best incorporate Alpha Phi Omega's Online Information Session video into your chapter's recruitment plan.

## **OPTION #1: SELF-GUIDED**

Prospective members will have the opportunity to learn about Alpha Phi Omega independently by taking the following steps:

- 1. Gather a list of all prospective members acquired from the chapter's recent recruitment efforts
- 2. Ask prospective members to navigate and view <u>Alpha Phi Omega's Information Session</u> video within one week by visiting the APO mobile resource app, the APO website or by connecting with an officer of the chapter
- 3. Contact all prospective members one week after the initial contact to answer questions and extend an invitation to become a pledge or new member of Alpha Phi Omega

## OPTION #2: GROUP

Chapter officers - like pledge or new member educator - can utilize the following meeting agenda to host a virtual or socially distant meeting where prospective members can learn more about the Fraternity:

- 2. Overview of meeting agenda
- 3. Watch Alpha Phi Omega's Information Session video (9:17)
- 4. Discuss the following chapter-specific topics
  - v. Overview of chapter programming and events
  - vi. Pledge or new member ceremony details
  - vii. Preparing for active membership through education
- 5. Question and answer session
- 6. Next steps and conclusion
